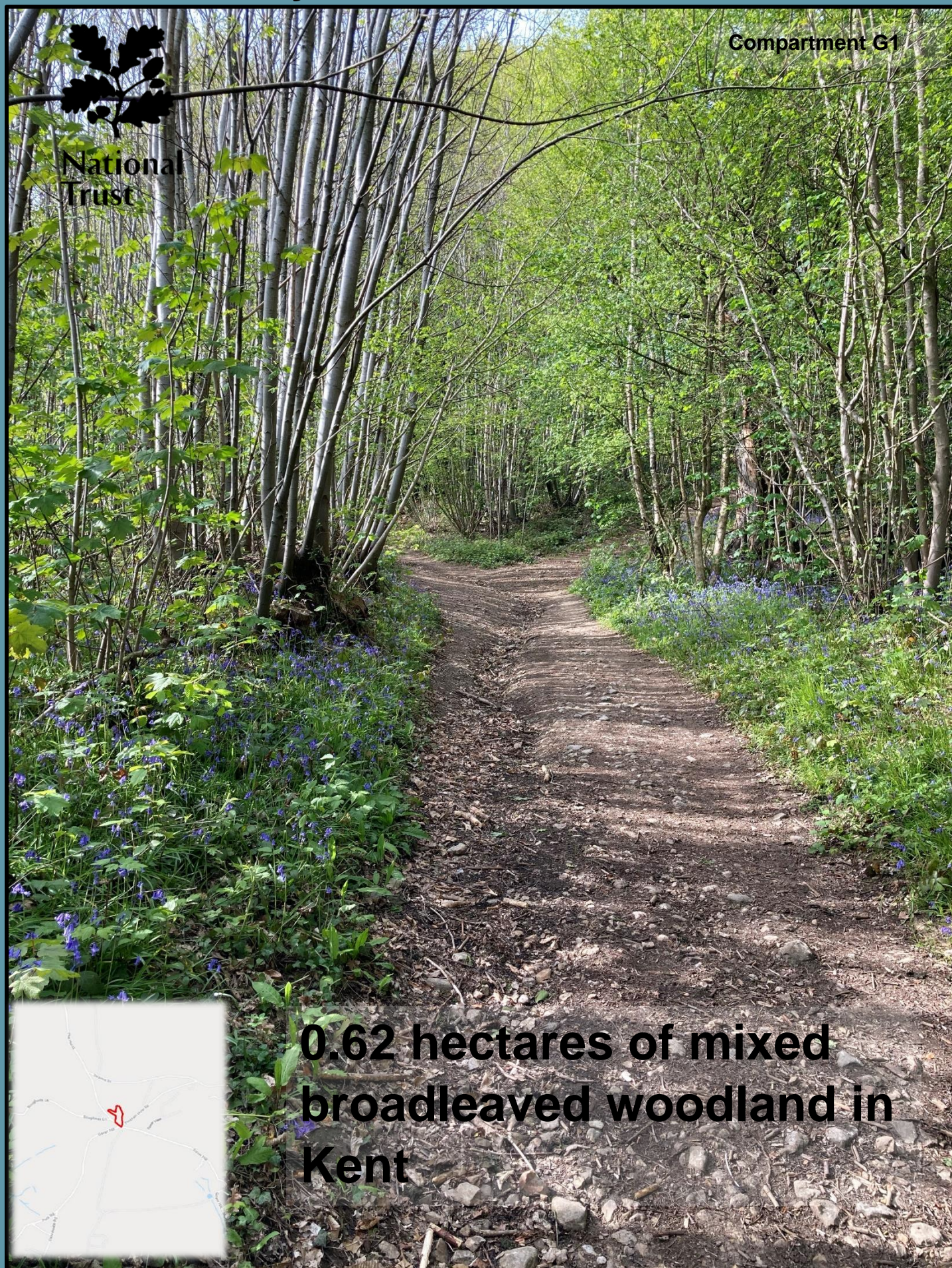


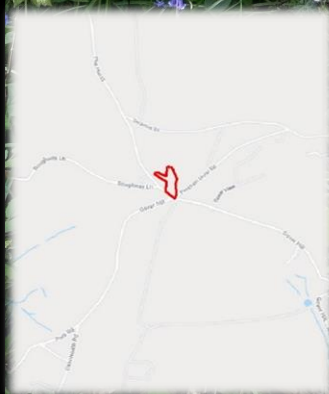

# Habitats and Species

This is a block of mature native beech oak and hazel woodland with areas of planted sweet chestnut coppice and self-seeded sycamore.

## Designations

Gover Hill has been designated as Ancient Semi-Natural Woodlands (ASNW), this means it is a woodland that has existed continuously since or before 1600. In these compartments work will focus on maintaining and enhancing the health and diversity of the woodland habitat, protecting veteran trees, and management for health and safety.

## Management Approaches

Coppicing will be used to maintain and enhance structural diversity
