Habitats and Species

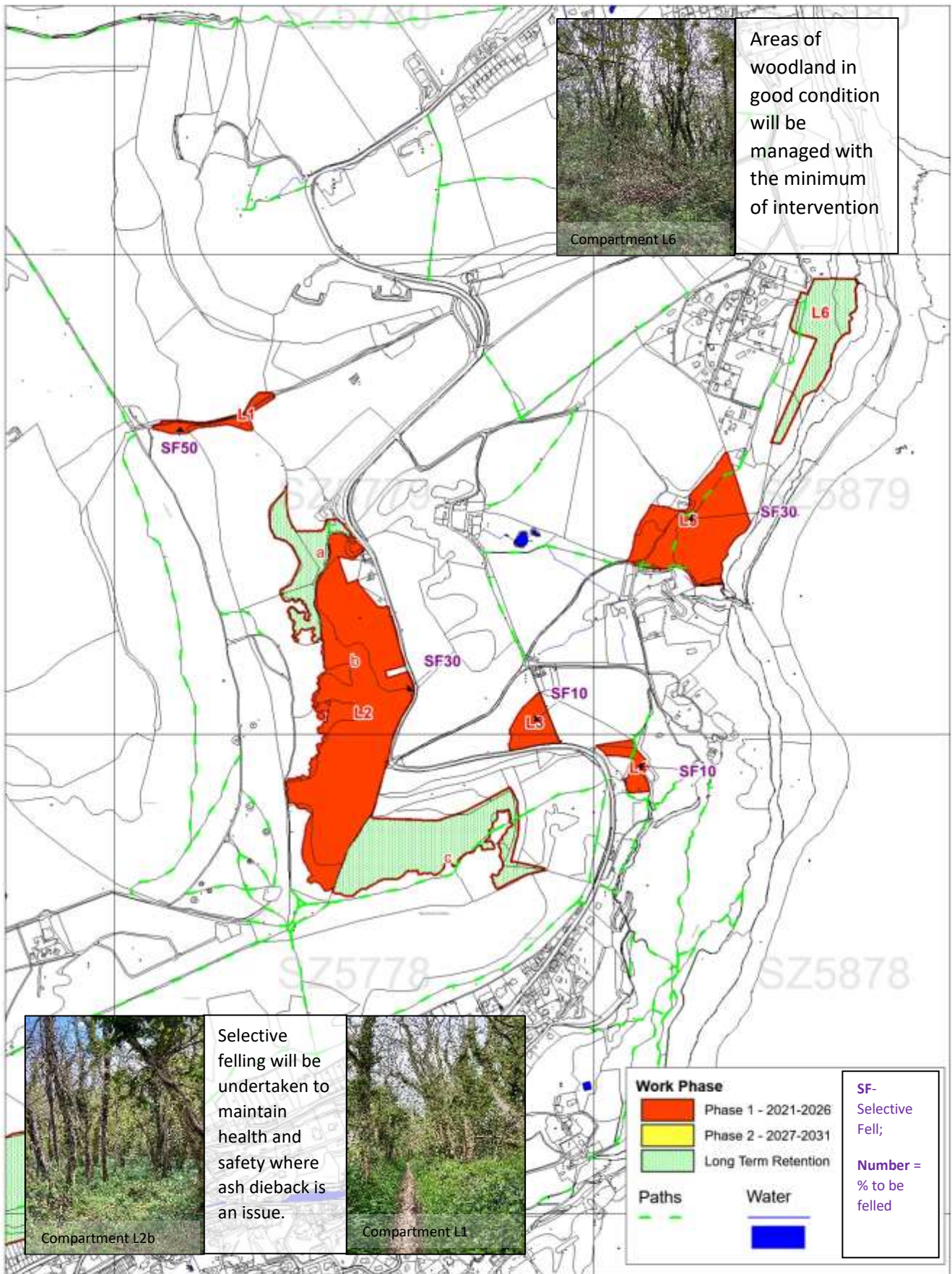
Luccombe contains areas of ancient semi-natural woodland, with a rich ground flora including ramsons, bluebell and yellow archangel. Semi-natural ash and sycamore forms cliff-top woodland, with a locally rich ground flora. These woodland types are covered by the UK BAP lowland mixed deciduous woodland Priority Habitat.

Designations

L2 sit in the Ventnor Downs SSSI, noted for chalk grasslands. L2b is classified as Ancient Semi Natural Woodland which means it has been continuously wooded since 1600.

Management Approaches

Where possible, the woodland here will be left to mature naturally. Unfortunately, some areas have been badly effected by ash dieback. Where this presents a health and safety issue, we will used selective felling to make these trees safe.
